


The World Health Organization States

23% of all global deaths are attributed to environmental factors

predicted additional climate-related deaths annually by 2030 250,000

The World Health Organization's study consisted of 74 women and 40 men with a response rate or 54%. the study looked To address educational gaps on students understanding of, "The Impact of Climate Change on Human Health".

The study evaluated its effectiveness by completing a pre/post-course survey that measured changes in their beliefs, attitudes, and knowledge about the health effects of climate change.


The World Health Organization attributes 23% of all global deaths to environmental factors, and it projects an additional 250,000 climaterelated deaths annually by 2030

To address this educational gap on students, "The Impact of Climate Change on Human Health." Students (40/74, 54% response rate) evaluated its effectiveness by completing a pre/post-course survey that measured

changes in their beliefs, attitudes, and knowledge about the health effects of climate change.
